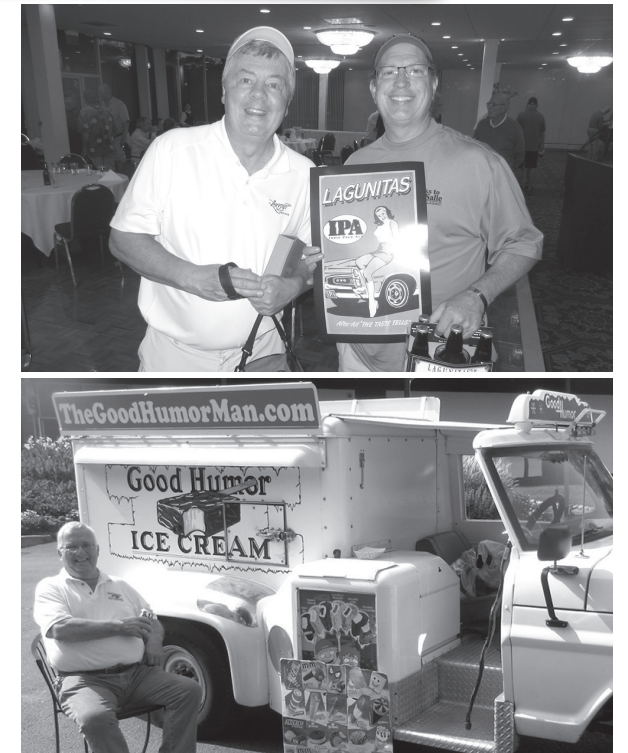
Annual Alumni Golf Outing was another Ace in the Hole!
