To maintain the health and safety of our alumni, we will continue to follow updated COVID, Delta variant and CDC recommendations. The Saint George Alumni Association is requiring your awareness of the following:

- 1. We're assuming that all luncheon attendees and their guests will be fully vaccinated.
  - 2. If you and your guest are NOT fully vaccinated, you must provide a negative COVID test result 72 hours prior to attending.
    - 3. If you choose not to attend our Luncheon, a full refund will be issued.

Chevy Chase is following current CDC guidelines, with posted signs indicating that unvaccinated guests are required to wear masks. They are not, however, requiring proof of vaccination at this time.

At this point, our office has 95 confirmed reservations for the October 4 Luncheon. We have received no calls voicing concerns or decisions to cancel.

#### Alumni Spotlight: Captain John Harold Leims

Captain John Harold Leims, a St. George graduate, was the recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, the United States government's most prestigious military decoration to recognize American military personnel who have distinguished themselves by acts of valor. The Congressional Medal of Honor is the United States' highest award for military valor in action.

John Harold Leims was born in Chicago, IL, on June 8, 1921. He attended St. Hilary Parochial School, Archbishop Quigley Preparatory Seminary, and graduated from Saint George High School in 1939. At Saint George, he played varsity football and track, was sports editor of the school paper, and was an Assistant Scoutmaster in the Boy Scouts of America.

Enlisting in the Marine Corps Reserve in 1942, he was assigned to the 3rd Service Battalion, 3rd Marine Division. He left for overseas duty with that unit on February 23, 1943. After four months in New Zealand and two months at Guadalcanal, he was selected for officer training and returned to the United States in September 1943. He was commissioned a Marine second lieutenant on March 1, 1944, at Quantico, Virginia.

Landing on Iwo Jima on February 24, 1945, he was slightly wounded by a shell fragment, but returned to duty on the same day. On March 3, due to heavy casualties, he became company commander, a position usually filled by a captain. On March 7, he led his company in a surprise attack against a strongly fortified enemy hill position, succeeded in capturing the objective, and in spite of withering fire returned forward to rescue two of his wounded men. He recieved the Medal of Honor, presented to him by President Harry S. Truman in a White House ceremony, in 1946. He died on June 28, 1985, at the age of 64, and was buried at Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia.
